Each person in a group entry will need to complete the form(s). If you have created a piece that is large or 3D please send us some photographs of your work. We may contact you to send your original piece to the Council Offices.

If your entry is a recording/image (e.g. a song/rap/performance), please email us a video of your work or send us a CD copy. If you use images of peoples' faces you will need to complete the Photo Consent form as well along with a photo so we can see who the form relates to.

Deadline for entries is the **29<sup>th</sup> of May**. A professional panel of judges will choose the final winners and the successful applicants will be notified that they have won by the **15<sup>th</sup> June 2018** and will be invited to a special prize giving ceremony on the **10<sup>th</sup> July 2018** during the school day. The top 10 entries from each Key Stage will be put into an eBook. These short listed winners will receive a MK Dons Prize.

There will be prizes for the winner and runner up in each of the 5 Key Stages.

**First Prize** = £100 Shopping Voucher and a FREE First Aid Course delivered to your school. **Second Prize** = £50 Shopping Voucher **Third Prize** = £25 Shopping Voucher.

## **Rules, Terms and Conditions for the Mental Health & Me: Milton Keynes Competition**

Competition Entry form must be completed by all people entering a 'creative piece'.

You can only enter once, either as a member of a group or as an individual.

If entering as a group the prize money will have to be shared equally between members of the group. If the 1<sup>st</sup> place winners go to different schools then a community group should use the first aid training.

Think about the content in your work ensuring that it is not slanderous or derogatory and if it is appropriate for public viewing.

Please make sure that the information you provide us with is correct and if successful you can be contacted once the winners have been decided.

Make sure all content is original and is not someone else's work.

All entries need to be residents of Milton Keynes or attend a school in Milton Keynes.

You must be U19 to enter this competition unless you are attending a special needs school in Milton Keynes.

Do not use other people's details in your work. No one should be identifiable.

Do not use any copyrighted materials or brands in your work.

All content submitted will become property of Milton Keynes Youth Cabinet / Milton Keynes Council.

Images will be on full view unless you chose to blur them prior to entry.

All photographic/ images in films, photos etc. should be accompanied with a completed photo consent form for each person in the image.

Shortlisted winners and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners will be included in Mental Health & Me: Milton Keynes e-book.

The Mental Health & Me: Milton Keynes e-book will be widely available on the internet for the public to see.

The organising committee and MK Council have the right to refuse entries.

Data Protection: Your information will be used by the Community Learning Department at MK Council for the purposes of the MK Youth Cabinet Mental Health Project. We require the above for the purposes of informing the shortlisted and the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners and in turn the school/community group too and for the E-book. Winners information will be shared with MK Council, Arriva, Green Cross Training and MK Dons (Prize Givers) for the purpose of informing the organisations of those who have won prizes. In conjunction with the prize winners, information will be shared with the Press for publicity purposes. Unless those shorted/winners have asked for anonymity, the E-book will hold details of a first name along with their creative work. Any images will need photo consent completed in advance of the competition. Information on the photo consent forms will be kept for the purpose of the photographic image use, if the image is included in the E-Book. Information not needed or used will be disposed of securely.
